Chardonnay

Georges Michel: Talking about the Chardonnay, we make again two style of Chardonnay; one is called the Golden Mile range, and the other one is the Reserve range. The Golden Mile range is an easy-drinking, approachable wine that could age for four to five years, and it is good wine for, again, seafood or any kind of fresh salad, white meat, chicken, veal.

The Reserve range would be more complex on the nose and the palate. It is a ... it's a bigger wine; it's a mouth-filling wine; it's more complex; and it's made in the style of wine that would match very well with white cream-sauce dishes. And the potential, aging potential of that Reserve wine, Reserve Chardonnay, would be at least between seven and eight years old.

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
